Buffalo Soldiers National Museum (BSNM) is located in Houston Texas.

The Camp Logan Mutiny is also known as the Houston Riot of 1917. One result was 118 Buffalo Soldiers of the 24th Infantry Regiment were tried in three courts-martial, and 19 were executed. In 2023, those convictions were overturned after a <u>review</u> by the Army Board for Correction of Military Records.

The Wikipedia article explains that the original units existed from 1866 to 1918 (in two secions, Medal of Honor Recipients and Other Notable People). They might have some aviation experience. If so, that helps to connect them to us, the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA). 












AIAA Houston Section: Mexico and the Section's territory in Texas AIAA Region VII (International) and Region IV (Mexico and four states of the USA)

U.S. AMBASSADOR TO MEXICO – KEN SALAZAR



Ken Salazar was sworn in as United States Ambassador to Mexico on September 2, 2021.

In 2009, President Obama nominated Mr. Salazar to serve as Secretary of Interior where he had a lead role on the Obama-Biden agenda on energy and climate, the nation's conservation agenda including America's Great Outdoors, and Indian Country. Ambassador Salazar has been a lifelong fighter for civil rights and the inclusion of Latinos in the American dream.

In 1998, Mr. Salazar was elected as Colorado Attorney General and became the first Latino ever elected to statewide office in Colorado. He was reelected as Attorney General in 2002. In 2004, Attorney General Salazar was elected to the United States Senate for Colorado becoming the first Latino democrat to be elected to the United States Senate since 1972.

Ambassador Salazar has been admitted to practice law in state and federal courts, including the United States Supreme Court.

Ambassador Salazar and his family have farmed along the banks of the Rio Grande River in New Mexico and Colorado for more than four centuries.
