

I am enjoying the book "Birth of a White Nation" by Jacqueline Battalora. I bought the paperback version of the 2nd edition (2021). She mentions a book called "The Invention of the White Race, The Origins of Racial Repression," by Theodore W. Allen. I borrowed both volumes in a single 2021 eBook from the Harris County Public Library. Volume I was published in 1994 and its 2nd edition was published in 2012. Volume II was published in 1997.

Both authors explain that after Bacon's Rebellion, the richest of the elite created whiteness in law, starting in 1681 in Maryland. Richard Bell explains in episode 5 (A Free Black Family in Colonial Virginia) of his series of lectures (America's Long Struggle Against Slavery) for Great Courses, that in 1662 and 1667, two important anti-Black codes were passed in our colonies, but whiteness was created in law as a response to Bacon's Rebellion.

George Lipsitz wrote in his 1998 book on page viii that opposition to whiteness is not the same as opposition to white people. Also, one need not be white to participate in whiteness, he explained on that same page.



In YouTube videos, Battalora defines whiteness using descriptions such as divide and dominate and a pyramid scheme. Battalora, White, Bell, and Allen explain that after Bacon's Rebellion, whiteness was created to ensure that typical white and Black people never unite again. We continue our long struggle against whiteness today, though as Tim Wise said on YouTube or on his podcast, most people are good people.

Robert E. Lee High School still uses that name in our Houston area (Baytown). B. F. Terry High School (mascot: Rangers) in Rosenberg is even worse in some ways, as shown on their website.

Jeffrey Robinson explained in his Netflix special ("Who We Are") that while we remove Confederate monuments from public places, we rarely remove statues of Thomas Jefferson or George Washington because they were never honored for their relationships with slavery, unlike the people honored by every Confederate monument. Ken Salazar was sworn in as United States Ambassador to Mexico on September 2, 2021.

In 2009, President Obama nominated Mr. Salazar to serve as Secretary of Interior where he had a lead role on the Obama-Biden agenda on energy and climate, the nation's conservation agenda including America's Great Outdoors, and Indian Country. Ambassador Salazar has been a lifelong fighter for civil rights and the inclusion of Latinos in the American dream.

Ambassador Salazar has been admitted to practice law in state and federal courts, including the United States Supreme Court.


Ambassador Salazar and his family have farmed along the banks of the Rio Grande River in New Mexico and Colorado for more than four centuries.
